







Regional NSW ages fast and needs more young workers




Population in Rest of State NSW by age in 2024 and 2034; Centre for Population


















Gross Value Added per worker by industry, 2023; ABS Australian National Accounts


Coal, oil, and gas dominate global energy usage




Workforce in NSW by skill level from 1987 to 2023; ABS data


